Is it against the law to feed the cranes in Florida?

In 2002, the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission made it illegal to intentionally feed sandhill cranes in Florida (Floridae 68A-4.001(6)). When cranes are fed and learn to associate people with food, they can lose their fear of humans. Many sandhill cranes are killed each year on Florida roads.

People also ask, what is the fine for feeding sandhill cranes in Florida?

Most citizens do not know it is illegal to feed the cranes, as well as raccoons, alligators and foxes, under Florida Administrative Code 68A-4.001. It is a second-degree misdemeanor punishable by up to 30 days in jail and a \$500 fine. Wildlife officers will respond to reports of citizens feeding cranes.



Review the Bulletin Board and our Website to keep informed of what is happening at the flying fields.

The main gate at the flying field 52 must be kept locked when entering or leaving the field. The four tumblers must be turned each time the lock is closed. When entering the field if you find only one tumbler has been turned, try to find the last member who entered the field and closed the lock incorrectly. Explain to the individual that all four tumblers must be turned.
