UPDATE AS OF APRIL 26, 2020

- 1. AMA has formed a coalition with 15 different suppliers such as Tower Hobbies for additional support when dealing with FAA.
 - 2. Remote ID continues to be an issue with no solution in sight.
- 3. No solution for the control of Designated Flying Fields and altitude flying of 400, 600, and 1000 feet.
- 4. Testing of RC Pilots by AMA not an issue at this time.
- 5. AMA executive, Tyler Dobbs, travels to DC twice monthly to deal with FAA. He usually reports his findings on AMA AIR.
- 6. AMA Grant Awards will be announced mid May. I have requested a \$3000.00 grant to help pay for our new mowing machine.
 - 7. AMA's National Flying Site, located in Muncie, Indiana is closed because of COVID-19.
 - 8. AMA has canceled May Nats and possibly June Nats because of COVID-19.
- 9. AMA has compiled a list of websites and tools that could help small business such as hobby shops during this financial crisis.
