I would like to thank the pilot support and all the BCF members who help prior, during and after the event.



Congress has mandated that FAA consult with UAS (Unmanned Aircraft Safety Team) to establish a testing program for unmanned aircraft pilots. The scope of the test seems to be referring to safety and aircraft knowledge. AMA is working with FAA regarding this testing. I spoke with AMA on 10/4/2019 and was informed the testing should be very simple and can be taken on line without any fee. This would be a one time test. Failing the test or not taken it will not interfere with renewing membership with AMA. In the latest issue of Model Aviation magazine, an article appeared (pages 8 and 9) about a possible FAA Safety and Aircraft knowledge test. Please read it. If you have any question please email me.


