To the best of my knowledge FAA has not completed the reveiw of the 53,000 suggestions made by AMA members. Remote ID and altitude restriction are still undecided. No update on the safety test for all pilots other than it will be so easy anyone can pass it.

The FAA has launched a pilot program to translate into Spanish selected web content for users of Unmanned Aircraft Systems refered to as drones. The program is expected to reach the nearly 25.6 million people living in the United States with Limited English Proficiency and will focus on Spanish, the most widely spoken language in the U.S. other than English.
