September 2021 Leader Member Report

The August 2021 Model Aviation magazine (page 38) contains a good article on the Trust Test and the many organizations helping to improve the safety of our hobby. Pay close attention to the Documentations and Certifications paragraphs on page 40 and 41 especially for the following: Be aware, Altitude, Seeing and avoiding other aircraft and Following a CBO's safety guidelines. It is a Federal Law that all RC Pilots must take the Trust Test. However, the Trust Test is not required to renew or join AMA or BCF.

The FAA recently released a draft Advisory Circular (AC) 91-57C which will soon replace the current version, AC 91-57B. AMA has requested changes to the language regarding FPV operations, sanctioned events, CBO safety guidelines, and a variety of other points.

Review the Bulletin Board and our Website to keep informed of what is happening at the flying fields.

The main gate at the flying field 52 must be kept locked when entering or leaving the field. The four tumblers must be turned each time the lock is closed. When entering the field if you find only one tumbler has been turned, try to find the last member who entered the field and closed the lock incorrectly. Explain to the individual that all four tumblers must be turned.
